

Glicolico

Indications:-



Age spots, Melasma, Chloasma, Improves fine lines, Clarifies and reduces skin pigmentation, Skin with dyschromias, Pigmentation changes caused by acne or scarring.

Composition:-

70 % Glycolic acid 7 % Lactic acid 2% Salicylic acid
7 % Citric acid. 7 % Kojic acid

Application method:-

pH 0.1-2.0

1ml to 1.5ml for 1 full coat on the face, some client may require another coat if essentials, safe to use any part of the body.

End point:-

Average degree of Erythema (3-4 minutes). Skin sensitivity may vary from one spot to another; the Erythema in the more sensitive areas may more intense and certain areas may start to whiten as a result of flocculation. These will need to be partially neutralized using a swab or cotton wool ball soaked in water to ensure a Erythema is as uniform as possible.

Neutralize the peel using towels or sponges soaked with plenty of cold water after 3-4 minutes. Dry carefully. Apply a non comedogenic moisturizing cream after washing.

***Daily Care:-** Apply a non comedogenic moisturizer and sun screen.*

Frequency:-

This treatment should be carried out every 15 days.

Total number of sessions will be 08.
